

Rules and Regulations of the Radical Racing Network Team (RRN - Team for short)

First of all, we would like to thank the riders who have been loyal to us for many years, as well as the many guest riders. Our community has been growing steadily since the first Wednesday races started at Rouvy in 2019. As we see ourselves as amateur and hobby riders, a few rules have become necessary, which we will continue to adapt through changes. The races at Rouvy are evaluated in the form of a GC either via Niteor or as a separate Excel file of the RRN - Team and published with the data provided by Rouvy. By participating in the Rouvy races, you confirm that the data provided by Rouvy and Niteor may be processed.

Our position:

We are amateur and hobby riders, not professionals. For this reason, we have defined internal performance limits, which we use as a guide for our evaluation. We check several values, such as performance over 20 minutes, 60 minutes, sprint values, etc. To ensure that the check can be carried out more accurately and, above all, quickly, a friend request must be sent to or accepted by the organisers on Rouvy ([@Hubschraubär](#) , [@karl-rudolf](#) , [@Jens RRN](#)).

A friendship with the race organiser is mandatory. If we have any questions about your values, we will contact you. If this is not possible or if the values are significantly above our limits, we will issue a DSO.

Fair play: every participant undertakes to be fair and honest. This applies, for example, to the correct indication of their weight or gender. Performance-enhancing actions, such as medication or technical modifications, also fall under this clause.

- The use of a smart trainer is mandatory.
- Each participant must measure their heart rate during the race and transmit this data to Rouvy.
- Friend requests from the organisers on Rouvy must be accepted. We use the insight into your data to verify your values if necessary.
- In case of uncertainty, we will ask you for examples of your outdoor riding and compare these with your performance. Results with an average power output of more than 5W/kg in races (except HIT races) will be removed from the ranking without further review.

- Be polite and respectful to others!

Ranking mode for individual riders:

- Every rider who starts a race earns points for that stage.
- In the event that there are several races for one stage (always on the same route), your first race of the respective stage counts towards the ranking.
- Points are also awarded for DNF, DSO and riders who were riding without HR. (However, these riders do not receive any points themselves!)
- The races are created on Niteor, and the overall ranking (GC) is managed externally. The age groups are taken from Rouvy specifications.

- In the event of a tie in the GC, the rider who has completed the points with fewer rides/stages is ahead. If there is still a tie, the number of wins, 2nd places, 3rd places, etc. applies

Additional rules for series with team rankings:

- A team consists of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 people
- A participant may only be a member of one team.
- Mutual support between team members during races, e.g. by drafting, is permitted.
- Teams must form themselves; to do so, they must register on the platform <https://www.niteor.com/>. It is sufficient for one (1) rider from the team to be registered with Niteor.
- Team entries are possible until the start of the first race in a race series
- Late entries for teams require a request via private message to the organisation in the [RennRad News Forum](#)
- The three best teams per season will be listed in the Hall of Fame on RRN

Scoring mode for teams::

- For the team scoring, the points of the 3 best-ranked team members per team and race are added together and assigned to the team (see scoring mode for individual riders)
- The observation period is the defined duration of a series.
- In the event of a tie at the end of the observation period, the better team result from the last race will count.
- The results of the team scoring can be viewed on Niteor.

Rule violations:

- Participants have 48 hours after the publication of the scoring to lodge an appeal. After that, the result is considered accepted.
- The organisers reserve the right to remove participants from individual race results or from the race series in the event of rule violations or extreme irregularities.
- Sanctions will be imposed in the form of a DSQ.

In the team classification via Niteor, DSQ riders will be communicated in the results list and points received will be deleted. All other riders retain their points. In the solo classification, riders with a DSQ will be removed from the classification and the riders behind them will move up.

Objections & communication:

Communication with the organisers, especially in the case of sanctions, must take place within 48 hours exclusively via private messages on the [RennRad News Forum](#) platform to the users [@Hubschraubär](#), [@karl-rudolf](#), [@Jens RRN](#)
